- The total fee is estimated at \$1,950, subject to adjustment when we make final travel arrangements - group fares usually are not available until six to eight months before flight. If you are selected, a \$50 deposit will be due by August 1st to hold your place in the group. The balance of the fee will be due in installments from October 2009 to June 2010.
- The applicant agrees to live the Scout Oath and Law, to obey and cooperate with Scout leaders, and to meet full responsibilities as a member of the Blair Atholl Tour Group.
- The group will meet about once a month from October 2009 to June 2010, and there may be a pre-trip shakedown campout. While we will be understanding of one or two conflicts during the year, attendance at meetings and the campout should be considered mandatory. Excessive failure to attend meetings will be grounds for removal from the group.
- I hereby approve this application, certify to its correctness, and acknowledge that I have read and understand the conditions the application is subject to.
- In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the applicant's participation in the Baden-Powell Council Contingent Tour to the Blair Atholl Jamborette, and the activities before and after the Jamborette, any and all claims against the Boy Scouts of America or Baden-Powell Council, or any of the officers, employees, volunteer leaders, agents or other representatives of the aforementioned, or any other persons working under the direction or engaged in the conduct of their affairs, arising out of any accident, illness, injury, damage or other loss or harm incurred or suffered by the applicant, named above, or to his or her property in connection with or incidental to the Blair Atholl Tour, including preliminary training and travel, are hereby expressly waived.
